Viking's Grand Voyages and Extended Journeys range from 22 to 93 days. Some combine two or more cruise itineraries; others are special sailings that may only happen once during the year. IN-DEPTH EXPLORATION. Visiting a wide range of destinations on one seamless journey, these extensive voyages can also provide the gift of additional time. On a three-week sailing in the Mediterranean, you are in port every day—allowing you to absorb even more of the region's culture. With a longer itinerary, you may take time to enjoy the amenities and enrichment on board your elegant Viking ship. Listen to Destination Performances from local musicians; attend iconic lectures from our Viking Resident Historians; and relax in our Nordic-inspired spa after your time ashore. Perhaps you may start a new evening tradition, exchanging stories with friends over glasses of Aquavit in the Explorers' Lounge.

ship relocates from one part of the world to another. These sailings are only offered periodically and can provide the opportunity to explore smaller ports and lesser-known destinations. For instance, you may be interested in the 44-day voyage, From the Arctic to Antarctica. Sailing on board our new Viking Polaris expedition vessel, you will travel from Norway's northernmost town, south across the Atlantic and the equator, as your ship makes its way along the eastern coast of South America toward the intriguing "Last Continent." On the other side of the world, the Grand Pacific Explorer combines six shorter itineraries into one 93-day epic voyage on board Viking Orion, from Vancouver to Auckland, calling in Alaska and the Aleutians, visiting Tokyo and Osaka in Japan, encountering exotic Komodo dragons in their natural habitat and stopping in tropical Bali.

ECONOMIES OF SCALE. With our Grand Voyages and Extended Journeys, not only are you able to immerse yourself in world culture over an extended period of time, these itineraries are also more economical because you pay for just one roundtrip flight itinerary, therefore allowing you to maximize your time with Viking, rather than in transit.
