### POLO GRILL

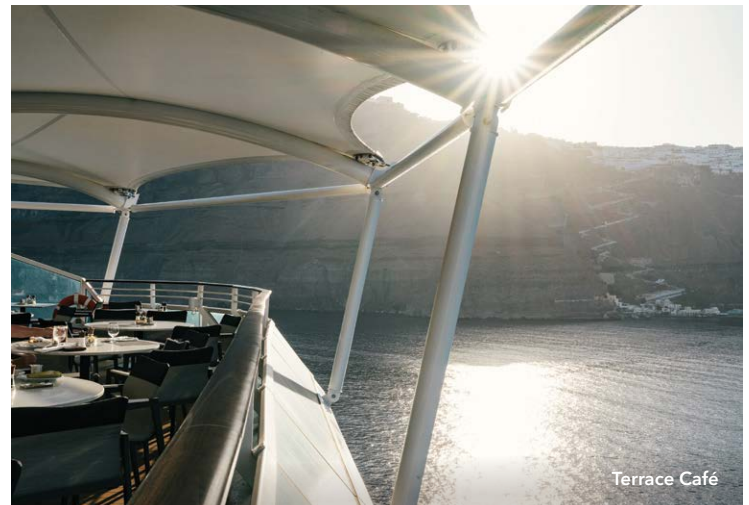

### YOUR HOME *at sea*

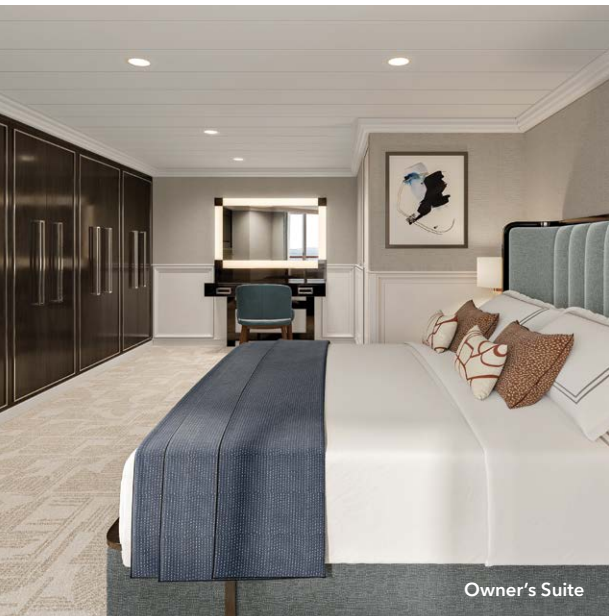
