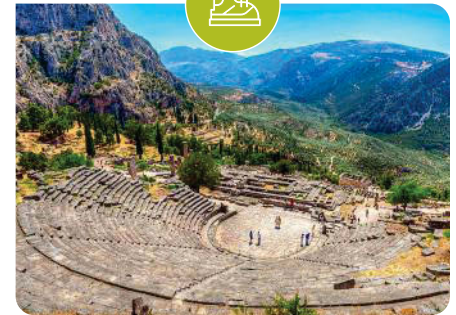
### Walking is a way of life on car-free Hydra

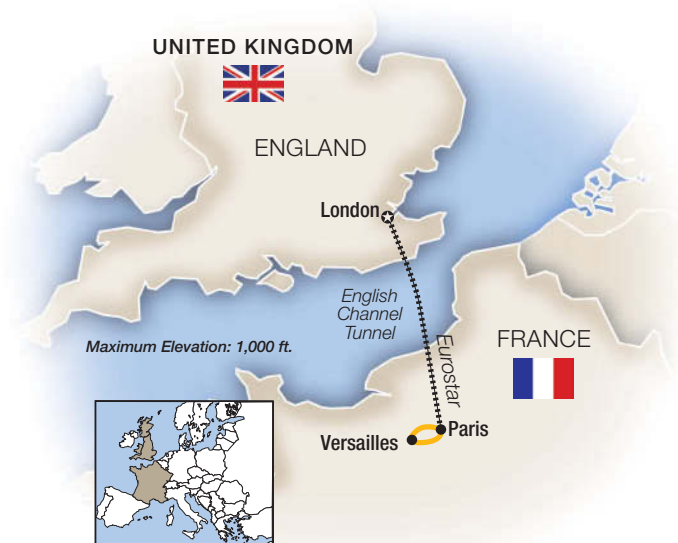

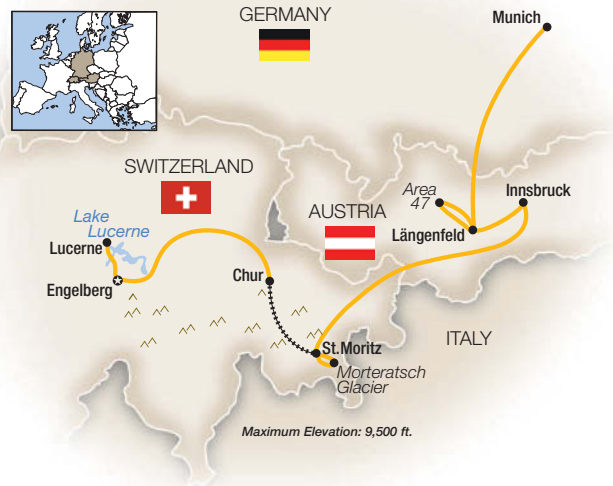

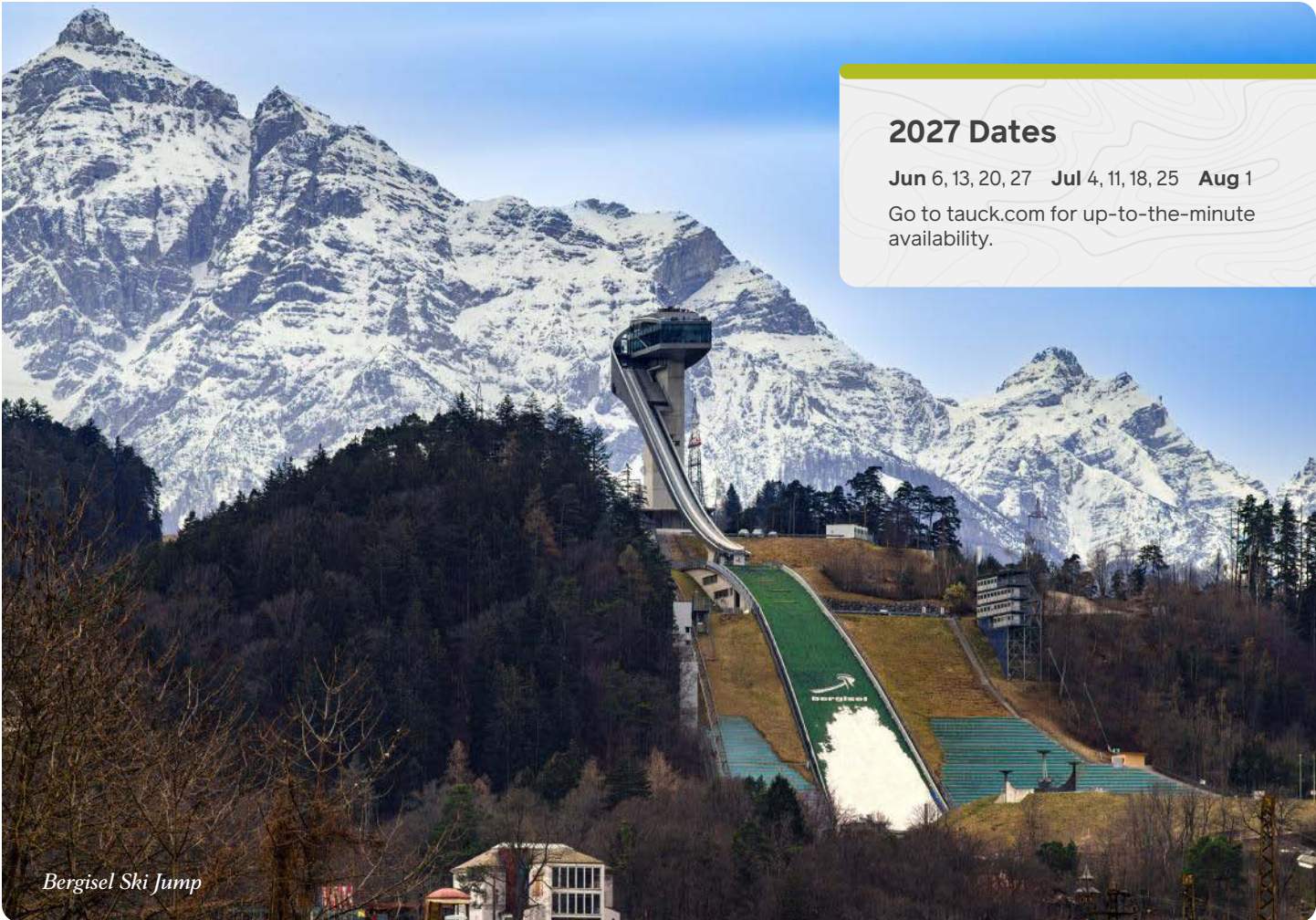
